## SEXUAL ABUSE REPORTING DECISION TREE Abuse, **SEXUALITY** Neglect, **UNDER 13 YRS** Immediate Report to authorities as Child Abuse Danger Presence of Methamphetamine creation Other party is a Custodial Authority: Caregiver, guardian, parent, relative, living in home, was in exercise of care/custody (e.g., teacher, babysitter, coach) creates a presumption of abuse, neglect and immediate danger SEXUALITY AGE >= 13 YRS Other party is not a Custodial Authority Victim is Victim is Willing Unwilling >= 4 yrs age < 4 yrs age Rape or difference difference sexual battery Juvenile Statutory disorderly conduct Mitigaged Victim 15-18 Age diff 4 to <=5 yrs "Standard" (Not Mitigaged or Aggrevated) Aggrevated Victim 13-18 Age diff >10 yrs

No authority to break confidentiality as "Child Abuse". Consider report to parents of the activity if in the best interests of child to have the issue addressed outside of counseling. Consider the following: Could issue fit under "neglect" if parent doesn't address the issue after being notified?
